



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Irish Malt Whiskies

Irish whiskies can be characterised by their smooth taste of honeyed malt and barley, which is partly a result of their triple distillation process.



Old Midleton Distillery, County Cork

Green Spot 22

Full bodied with no apologies. Oily linseed cooled by strains of gentle menthol, joined by some spiciness towards the end.

Jameson 18yo Limited Reserve 37

A complex taste and lingering finale of wood spice and toffee. Matured in a combination of bourbon and Oloroso sherry casks.

Jameson Black Barrel 14

A mellow pot still whiskey with nutty, sherry flavours and a rich lasting finish.

Jameson Caskmates IPA Edition 13

Matured in Irish Pale Ale seasoned barrels. There is a lemony, hoppy floral nose and finish. Slick and sweet with vanilla notes that tame down those other flavours quite a bit.

Jameson Caskmates Stout Edition 13

As expected, there is the initial sweet mouth coating typical of Irish Pot Still Whiskey. The effect of the beer cask finish becomes apparent with the subtle touch of hops and cocoa beans.

Jameson “The Whiskey Makers’ Series - Blenders Dog” 17

A whiskey from Billy Leighton, Head Blender at Jameson - *“I wanted to create harmony and complexity, an infusion of flavour that perfectly fills your mouth and nose. My whiskey has a rich and creamy mouth feel, with the sweetness of butterscotch, giving way to the prickle of spices and tannins”.*

Jameson “The Whiskey Makers’ Series - Coopers Croze” 17

Created by Head Cooper, Ger Buckley, aiming to display the diversity of barrels at the Midleton Distillery. Initially sweet vanilla, this whiskey then moves into touches of hazelnut and toasted wood, with a deliciously long finish.

Jameson “The Whiskey Makers’ Series - Distillers Safe” 17

Made by Brian Nation, Head Distiller at Jameson, celebrating his mastery of the Irish Pot Still. *“I have created a whiskey with the smooth mouth feel of pot still whiskies, combined with the soft buttery sweetness and gentle fruit notes of grain whiskey”.*

Midleton Very Rare 41

Mandarin and nutmeg with baking notes from warm raisin scones and old fashioned heavy cake. Savoury and dignified finish with touches of clove and green pepper.

Paddy 17

A soft malted nose with distinctive nutty malt and charred wood on the palate.



Old Midleton Distillery, County Cork

Redbreast 12yo 21

A complex nose of spicy fruit with toasted wood noted and an assertive palate of spice and barley.

Redbreast 15yo 28

Aromas of fruit compote, cinnamon and clove. Good clean streak running through it, but the rich spiciness dominates. A dry, peppery, spicy finish.

Redbreast Lustau Edition 23

Rich infusion of dark fruits, prunes, dates and figs with liquorice, marzipan, toasted oak and Redbreast spices. Sweetness and pot-still spices endure while oloroso sherry and Spanish oak have the last word.

Tullamore Dew 12

A spicy yet mild malted blend with a short finish of nuts and lingering vanilla notes.

Yellow Spot 24

Bright gold, brass appearance. Gorgeous aromatics with notes of wild honey, custard, creme caramel and almond flan. Given a little time sees some lovely fruits emerge, namely apple peel and pear. Entry is oily, buttery in turn as the spices develop in a double wave. Flavours of vanilla custard tart feature enlivened by soft spices. Outstanding length and balance concluding with impressive persistence.

Hyde Whiskey Distillery, County Cork

Hyde No. 3 The Aras Cask Irish Whiskey 15.5

Cinnamon and clove with succulent sweet caramel flavours. Complex and spicy with sweet American bourbon notes.

Hyde No.4 President's Cask Irish Whiskey 17

A 6 year old single malt Irish whiskey, released as part of the Hyde range. The No.4 Presidents cask expression has enjoyed a finishing period in casks that previously were home to some tasty rum, and have imparted notes of zesty tropical Caribbean fruits, vanilla and butter toffee.

Powerscourt Distillery, County Cork

Powers Gold Label 18

Powers Gold Label is a Whiskey of superior quality with its distinctive pot still, spicy and honeyed flavour. Triple distilled and matured in specially selected American oak casks for richness and complexity.



Teeling Distillery, County Dublin

Teeling Pot Still 17

Aromas of hibiscus flowers, honeycomb, white grape flesh, grapefruit & citrus. On the palate there are hints of lychee, more white grape along with white pepper, warm, roasted peaches and baked biscuits. This is all wrapped up with a dry finish, hints of spice, roasted almonds and maple sugar lingering in the mouth.

Teeling Single Grain 16

Spice and fruit notes mingle with an underlying sweet nose with a dry finish dominated by wood and spice.

Teeling Single Malt 18

Vibrant with notes of melon, figs, toffee and lemon. A long finish with sweetness in harmony with dry tannins from the wood.

Teeling Small Batch 14

An inviting nose where vanilla and spice dance with a slightly moorish and sweet spice finish complimented by woody undertones.

Teeling Stout Cask 17

Chocolatey and rich, with a light hint of rye spice backing it up. Creamy caramel and vanilla, with layers of orange and plum.

Dublin Liberties Distillery, County Dublin

Dead Rabbit Whiskey 15

A whiskey created by the Dublin Liberties distillery and the founders of the New York's excellent "Dead Rabbit Saloon" one of the world's best cocktail bars. A blend of malt and grain whiskeys, this is matured first in bourbon casks before a finish in virgin American-oak casks for an extra kick of spice.

The Dublin Liberties 14

This 10-year-old single malt is abounding with aromas of delicate honey, powdered sugar and floral notes of apple blossom. Finished in 30 year old sherry casks providing flavours of baked plums and ripe red grapes. A lingering finish of rich, dark chocolate. Try this straight up, with just a drop of water.

Roe & Co Distillery, County Dublin

Roe & Co 13.5

A premium, blended Irish Whiskey, named in honour of George Roe, a true pioneer of Irish Whiskey. Refined, elegant, remarkable depth and aged in bourbon casks. Master Blender Caroline Martin has created a versatile, luxuriously smooth premium whiskey. Gold award winner in the Irish Whiskey Masters 2020.



Old Bushmills Distillery, County Antrim

Bushmills 10yo Malt 15

A single malt, rich and smooth with vanilla and honey notes.

Bushmills 16yo Malt 20

Sherry inspired notes of vanilla and fruit with a delicate long finish.

Bushmills 21yo Malt 38

It is a remarkably fresh and lively tasting malt, given its advanced years. Like the rest of the single malts from Bushmills, this is initially aged in both bourbon and sherry casks.

Bushmills Blackbush 14

Blended single malts matured in Oloroso sherry casks, full flavoured and slightly spicy.

The Sexton Single Malt 14

A pronounced peach and apricot note, along with sweet honey notes, some fresh citrus peel, and the dried fruit notes of raisin and fig typically associated with sherry cask matured whiskey. The finish is medium length, featuring sweet dried fruit and just a hint of bitterness.

The Shed Distillery, County Leitrim

Drumshanbo Single Malt 17

The second edition of “Galánta” which translates as “Bravery”. This time round, individually numbered bottles have been filled with triple distilled spirit after aging in single-use Kentucky Bourbon casks, hand selected by Head Distiller, Brian Taft. The distillery has imbued the malt with a delicious balance of vanilla and wood spice.

Drumshanbo Single Pot Still 14

Every precious drop of this Single Pot Still Irish Whiskey has been triple distilled at the Shed Distillery using malted Irish barley, un-malted Irish barley and Irish Barra Oats. Aged in Oloroso Sherry and Kentucky Bourbon casks with no added colour and no chill filtration, this 43% Single Pot Still is another creation proudly distilled by the Head Distiller, Brian Taft.



Cooley Distillery, County Louth

Connemara Peated Single Malt 14

Balance nose of heather, honey and peat finishing long with intense oak notes.

Great Northern Distillery, Dundalk, County Louth

Grace O'Malley Blended 13

A special blend, combining multiple batches of whiskey of varying age statements from 3 to 10 years old. Each batch of whiskey is matured in a range of barrel types, including French oak. The resulting blend delivers a whiskey perfectly balanced between flavour, age character, complexity and smoothness.

Grace O'Malley Dark Char Cask 15

A superior blend - it delivers a wonderful balance of fruitiness, age character, complexity and smoothness. Unique in Ireland due to its high content of double and triple distilled malt, this blend is finished in the master blender's charred casks to create a uniquely smooth, lightly roasted and smokey flavoured whiskey.

Grace O'Malley Rum Cask 14

A premium whiskey due to its high content of double and triple distilled malt, finished in aged Caribbean Rum casks for added rich spiciness.

The Proclamation 15

A blend of the finest grain whiskies from across Ireland. Crafted in small individual batches, offering a liquid of complex yet refined character. Triple distilled and aged in new American Oak, offering up a singularly smooth whiskey with a clean taste.

Riverstown, Dundalk, County Louth

The Tyrconnell Single Malt 13

Fresh, malty taste with a dry finish.

Slane Distillery, County Meath

Slane 10

Spicy at first but quickly sweetened with rich caramel, vanilla and butterscotch then a deep layer of dried fruit.

The Old Kilbeggan Distillery, County Westmeath

Kilbeggan Blended Irish Whiskey 13

Matured in oak casks with a smooth finish from the oldest licensed distillery in the world.



Walsh Whiskey Distillery, County Carlow

The Irishman Founders Reserve 13

This well rounded and finely balanced whiskey goes down a treat. It gives you hints of ripe fruits and vanilla on the palate with a long, lingering finish.

The Irishman Single Malt 15

A triple distilled whiskey that's aged in a combination of bourbon and Oloroso sherry casks.

Writers Tears Copper Pot 13.5

A unique pot still. Traditional spiced ginger, green apple notes, hidden amongst a honey milk chocolate flavour.

Glendalough Distillery, County Wicklow

Glendalough 7yo Single Malt 15

Rich and sweet, a premium single malt Irish whiskey with a touch of cinnamon and more than a hint of citrus fruits - think orange zest and lemon infused with vanilla ice cream.

Glendalough 13yo Single Malt 18

Deep butterscotch, honeycomb and rich lemon meringue balanced with citrus fruits and just a hint of a clove spice.

Glendalough Single Grain Double Barrel 12

The finish has lingering notes of ginger spices with a faint glimmer of almond to end a complex Irish whiskey from start to finish.

Cooraclare Rackhouse, County Clare

JJ Corry 'The Gael' 18

Stone fruits and ripe red apple on the nose; spicy cooked peach and apricot on the palate, with a hint of candied orange turning to marmalade in the finish.

JJ Corry 'The Hanson' 16

Bright and approachable. Waves of vanilla fudge and toasted coconut on the nose. A fresh palate of green apples and lemongrass give way to a zingy, mineralic finish.

Tipperary Distillery, County Tipperary

Tipperary - The Rising 1916 Edition 17.5

An 11 year old single malt bottled by the Tipperary Distillery. This was double distilled at an undisclosed Irish distillery and has been aged in ex-bourbon barrels.



Scottish Whiskies

Characterised by their distinct smokiness and quite often pungent aromas of peat.

Scottish Whiskies can be grouped into 3 categories:

Single Malts, Blended Malts & Vatted Malts.



Lowlands

Auchentoshan 3 Wood 16

A rich complex whisky with incredible toffee and sherry oak flavours.

Auchentoshan 12yo 15

A slightly dusty nose, with leafy notes and walnut or hazelnut husks. Gingery and slightly drying finish, with a pleasant lingering nuttiness

Highlands

Dalmore 12yo 17

Orange, marmalade and aromatic spice on the nose. On the palate it has intense citrus and hints of sweet vanilla pod to finish, enhanced by increased sherry wood for an aftertaste of great complexity.

Dalwhinnie 15yo “Meeting Place” 15

A sweet and soft heather nose followed with deep citrus and malted bread flavours.

Glenmorangie 10yo 16

Fruit and caramel on the nose with a warm fruity finish.

Highland Park 12yo 13

Matured for a minimum 12 years in Oloroso casks of European and American oak. A perfect blend of salted butterscotch, malt, spice and fruit.

The Deveron 12yo 17

A light, fruity and approachable spirit with some nutty notes.

Western Highlands - Isle of Jura

Jura 16

A palate of light smoke lying above firm, young grassy notes.

Oban 14yo 16

A well known drop. Slightly smoky in flavour, the dry palate is enhanced with a rich body of autumn fruits and spice.



Speyside

Aberfeldy 12yo 15

Aged for 12 years and bottled at 40% ABV. A smooth dram of heather and honey. As golden in hand as the gold in its water source.

Aberfeldy 21yo 31

Has a heathery flavour that is typical of its region, but offers a diverse and well-rounded range of elements for both the palate and the nose. While restrained, there are discernible aromas of honey and ripe fruit, along with a malty overtone.

Aultmore 12yo 14

This expression offers a nose of peaches and lemonade, freshly mowed grass, linseed and milky coffee. Very fruity on the palate, mildly herbal, with toffee and light spices. The finish is medium in length, with lingering spices, fudge and finally more milky coffee.

Balvanie 12yo 16

Traditional vanilla and honey notes backed up by cinnamon spiciness, nutty sweetness and a delicate layer of sherry.

Cragganmore Single Malt 17

This Speyside malt has beautiful sweet notes with an added smoky maltiness on the finish.

Craigellachie 13yo 15

Light and fresh palate with nuts, malt, sulphur and sweet apples. To finish mild burning sensation, sweet apples and bits of cloves at first which turns to gentle sweetness.

Glenfiddich 12yo “Valley of the Deer” 14.5

An elegantly rounded fresh whisky with subtle oak influences and notes of pear and peat.

Glenfiddich 15yo 18

Delicately finished for up to 12 weeks in brand new American and new Spanish oak casks after being patiently matured for 14 years. Creamy vanilla and soft toffee sweetness, spiced oak with layers of ripe summer fruit, creating a rich and complex single malt.

Glenlivet Founders Reserve 17

A delicate, balanced whisky with floral and citrus flavours. There is a bright and fresh minerality, with lingering sweetness on the finish.

Macallan Double Cask 12yo 17

A blend of ex-American and Spanish oak that used to house bourbon and sherry impart a rich, yet delicate flavour onto this whisky.



Isle Of Islay

Ardbeg Single Malt 10yo 14

Ardbeg is known as the “ultimate Islay malt”. Of all the Islay malt distilleries, it is Ardbeg that most encapsulates the natural aromas, tastes and the “feel” of Islay. Rich blackcurrant and blueberries, bitter almonds with espresso and star anise.

Bowmore 12yo 15

The heart of the Bowmore range, this exhibits some beautiful coastal notes with a gentle peat, it is the balance that the floral element presents that makes this a great entry bottling for Bowmore.

Bowmore No 1 14

Bowmore No 1 is produced using single malt Scotch whisky drawn exclusively from first-fill bourbon casks, imparting a creamy sweetness which blends well with the robust Islay smoke that Bowmore is best known for.

Buichladdich “Octomore 13.1” Single Malt 20.5

Octomore 13.1 is as youthful and dynamic as its super-heavily peated predecessors. Distilled patiently from the 2015 harvest of 100% Scottish Mainland barley, this single malt is malted to a stratospheric 137.3 PPM and matured in the highest quality American oak casks.

Buichladdich “The Classic Laddie” 15

Fruity nose of conference pear, honeydew melon and red apple, combined with sweet vanilla and the faintest hint of salinity.

Lagavulin 16yo 16

Powerful peat and malted sweetness followed with complex dried peat and sherry notes.

Isle of Skye

Talisker 10yo 17

Nose of maritime saltiness and peat smoke with an explosive pepper and smoke finish.

Orkney Islands

Laphroaig 10yo 17

The quintessential Islay malt. Matured in 100% American oak, ex-bourbon casks. Bursts of maritime peat, vanilla and milk chocolate.



Scottish Blended Whiskies

Chivas Regal 12yo 13.5

A delightful nose of orchard fruits and honeyed sweetness with a round and creamy palate of ripe apples, vanilla and butterscotch.

Chivas Regal 18yo 21

Uniquely rich and multi-layered whisky produced from various malt and grain whiskies from all over Scotland including the Speyside malt “Strathisla”.

Chivas Regal Extra 18

Deep in aroma, rich in fruitiness and generous in sweetness. Aged in Spanish sherry casks where the rich sweetness of the sherry reacts to the oak wood of the cask.

Johnnie Walker Black 13.5

A sweet & fruity aroma with a touch of peat, leading to a palate of warm grain and oak with vanilla and butter note.

Johnnie Walker Blue 40

Containing whiskies of up to 60 years, it has a mature peaty flavour with distinct malt notes.

Johnnie Walker Double Black 15.5

Taking its cues from the flavours of Johnnie Walker Black, while being an unquestionably smokier, more intense experience, but with deep, dark roots.

Johnnie Walker Gold 24.5

Notes of soft raisins and toffee, fresh malt and light cream Gold Label is as enticing as it is sensuous with full malt flavours and honeyed spices with almonds and marzipan, distinctive creaminess.

Johnnie Walker Green 22.5

On the palate this one suggests vanilla, nutmeg, honey, cinnamon, mild amount of peat smoke. Very round, full and silky mouthfeel. The finish is soft, wisps of smoke with malt and toffee.

Johnnie Walker Red 13

Very aromatic aroma with a robust malt and grain, slightly spicy palate.

Monkey Shoulder 12

A blend of 3 whiskies - Balvenie, Kininvie and Glenfiddich, who lend their sweet, floral notes of vanilla and wood spice.

Teacher's 12

High proportions of peated highland single malt give this fantastic blend a light campfire smoke character, with sweeter flavours of apples, pears and heavy honey maturity showing through.



American & Canadian Whiskies

Buffalo Trace *Frankfort, Kentucky* 13.5

A pleasantly sweet and leathery blend.

Bulleit Bourbon 10yo *Kentucky* 13

Light flowery nose, with a dry smooth finish of vanilla and honey.

Bulleit Bourbon Rye *Kentucky* 15

Rich oaky aromas. The taste is exceptionally smooth, with vanilla, honey, and spice. Finish is crisp and clean.

Canadian Club Classic 12yo *Walkerville, Ontario* 13

Full and smooth with a soft and creamy aroma. This classic club has a delicate taste of spiciness and creamy vanilla, in balance with rich wood and honey. An enduring presence of butterscotch to finish.

Gentleman Jack Rare Tennessee Whiskey *Lynchburg, Tennessee* 14.5

Twice filtered through charcoal to give a unique mellow smoky flavour. Full bodied with fruit and spices.

Jack Daniel's Fire *Lynchburg, Tennessee* 13

Blends red hot cinnamon liqueur with the smooth character of Jack Daniel's Old No. 7.

Jack Daniel's Honey *Lynchburg, Tennessee* 13

A blend of Jack Daniel's Tennessee whiskey and a unique honey liqueur of our own making, for a taste that's one-of-a-kind and unmistakably "Jack". With hints of honey and a finish that's naturally smooth.

Jack Daniel's Single Barrel *Lynchburg, Tennessee* 16

Each barrel is hand-selected for its one-of-a-kind flavour, robust taste, and notes of oak, vanilla, and caramel.

Knob Creek 9yo *Clermont, Kentucky* 17

Matured for a minimum 9 years in heavily charred virgin American oak casks. Dried orange, balanced fruit, complex and toasty oak.

Knob Creek Rye *Clermont, Kentucky* 18

Predominantly made of rye grain, enhancing the peppery spice and tropical fruit characters with great caramel and toasty oak rounding out the finish.

Maker's Mark *Loretto, Kentucky* 14

The perfect combination of corn, barley and wheat, creating mellow grain notes throughout

Maker's Mark 46 *Loretto, Kentucky* 17

Take the original Makers Mark and further finish it for one Kentucky winter in virgin French oak. Richness and great complexity, with sweet caramels, vanilla, dark spices, toasted almonds, coconut and stone fruits.

Woodford Reserve *Versailles, Kentucky* 17

A masterpiece which is balanced with fruitiness and traditional vanilla notes.



Rum

Australia

Bundaberg Under Proof 11

Bundaberg provides a hint of vanilla and carefully selected spices which results in a smooth and aromatic rum.

Latin America & The Caribbean

Angostura Anejo 5yo 13

Subtle notes of chocolate, spice, vanilla and toasted oak flavours.

Bacardi Oakheart 12.5

Aged in charred oak barrels to impart a rich and smoky taste to Bacardi's famous recipe, the Oakheart is decadently smooth on the palate with an exciting spice kick.

Bacardi Ocho 13.5

Aged for at least 8 years in selected oak barrels. Bacardi 8 is blended to give a smooth, rich and full palate with a long finish.

Bacardi Fuego 12

Aged for a minimum of 2 years in torched barrels, flavours of nutmeg, cinnamon, orange peel and plum come to life.

Captain Morgan Spiced 11

A soft, rich golden rum from Jamaica with a hint of Asian five spice giving an extra edge behind the sweetness of sugarcane.

Pampero Añejo Especial 11

This rum owes its flavour and character to a combination of aged rum, vanilla, cocoa and spice.

Ron Zacapa 23yo Gran Reserva Rum 16

This spirit has intensity, volume of flavour and an attractive, mellow flavour that makes this the ultimate rum experience.

Sailor Jerry 11

A vanilla spice, oak and cinnamon nose, with a dry, long crisp finish.

The Kraken 13

Enriched with exotic spice notes of ginger, cinnamon and clove.



Vodka

The delicate flavour and rich mouth feel come from use of the highest quality ingredients and advanced production methods.

Belvedere 14

Produced in one of the world's longest operating polish distilleries that has been making vodka since 1910, Belvedere's Master Rye Distillers draw from a 600-year polish vodka-making history to artfully craft Polish rye into an extraordinary vodka of distinct taste and character.

Dingle 15

Dingle's original vodka is distilled in the village of Dingle, County Kerry, Ireland which is located on the western fringe of Europe. Buffeted by winds from the Atlantic Ocean, Dingle enjoys an unrivalled environment.

Grey Goose 15.5

Soft, rounded texture. Shows off rich fruit elements surrounded by beautiful aromatics. Lovely fragrance holds forth as backnotes of lighter spice and stone are discerned.

Ketel One 14

Crafted from small batches using copper pot stills with over 300 years of Nolet Family distilling expertise, Ketel One vodka delivers a crisp and sophisticated taste and flavour.

Sausage Tree Irish Pure Vodka 14

This Irish vodka is made with the fruit of the Kigelia Africana, also known as the sausage tree - because the fruit looks like sausages (Google it!) The fruit is combined with Irish grain and nettle to create a fascinating, lightly fruity and herbaceous vodka.

Stolichnaya 15.5

The entry is bright and airy, leading to a silky palate that has a tolerable bite at first that melts into a warm vodka taste with a hint of citrus.



Gin

Bombay Sapphire 13.5

A distinct lemon nose, followed by warm botanical notes that are highlighted by cinnamon and liquorice.

Glendalough 14

Fresh spring notes with juniper, citrus and pine. A forest clearing in bloom.

Hendrick's 14

An infusion of cucumber and rose petals that results in a most iconic gin.

Tanqueray 13

This gin is fairly oily and continues on the palate what was discovered on the nose, the coriander comes in a bit stronger in the palate and the finish. There's enough acidity in the gin to balance the sweetness.

Tanqueray No.10 14.5

The only gin in the "World Spirits Hall of Fame", it is made from the highest quality spirit and finest botanicals and delivers distinctly citrus flavours of grapefruit, oranges and limes



Irish Gin

Blackwater Barry's Tea 15.5

This release from Blackwater has been distilled using fresh juniper, sicilian lemons, green cardamom, angelica root, sweet spanish oranges and Barry's Tea.

Blackwater Wexford Strawberry 15.5

The strawberries for this gin were grown just outside Enniscorthy in County Wexford, by Susan Kearns.

Dingle 14

Contains locally foraged botanicals, including rowan berry, fuschia, bog myrtle, hawthorn and heather.

Drumshanbo Gun Powder 15

Delightfully fresh and rounded up front with citrus, juniper and spicy notes immediately evident. The expected juniper follows close behind. Gunpowder tea, meadowsweet and coriander are all notable.

Drumshanbo Gun Powder With Sardinian Citrus 15

Made with Citrus Monstruosa - a pulpy, bitter fruit native to Sardinia - the botanical ingredients remain similar to Drumshanbo's original "Gun Powder". Woody juniper and citrus peel on the nose while background liquorice root enters later on. Big on grapefruit tang and white pepper on the palate.

Dublin City 14.5

A premium handcrafted dry style gin with carefully selected botanicals, including organic rhubarb grown along the Grand Canal in Dublin itself. Jawbox Belfast Cut Classic Dry 15

Complex on the palate, citrus and juniper develop into peppery, earthy angelica root, finishing with citrus and lingering juniper and pine.
